

WHY REGENERATIVE FARMING?

Land

- Better yields with less input and increased production.
- Lower operating costs with less reliance on fertiliser or chemicals.
- Enhanced natural capital, with the opportunity to increase asset values by regenerating degraded land.
- The ability to sell to higher value markets such as consumers of organic or grass-fed products.
- Higher profitability with less volatility as holistic farms are more adaptive, and are able to respond better to climatic and biological variability.
